



Symposium for Young Researchers in Geo-Engineering - 7-9 November 2012 in Krakow

SYRGE 2012 is a low-cost intellectual arena for young scientists in Europe in the geo-engineering field. The conference venue is the beautiful city of Krakow in Poland during November 7-9 November 2012.

The conference is mainly arranged for research students and postdocs to meet in an informal setting to discuss and network to increase the cooperation between universities and researchers in Europe. The symposium is a multi-disciplinary arena where new ideas can be developed between young scientists.

The sessions consist of a series of 15 minute presentations about the research motivation and approach of the presenter. The presentations will be followed by an extended discussion where the participants can share their thoughts in a relaxed and comfortable manner. The cost of the symposium is 100 Euros and accommodation is arranged by the participants themselves. The conference will consist of presentation and discussion sessions in the following fields:

- Geo-environmental engineering
- Geology
- Geotechnical engineering

For organisational reasons, the participants are invited to submit a maximum one-page abstract to one or more of the following sessions:

- Geology
- Constitutive modelling
- Modelling of flow processes
- Numerical modelling
- Experimental research
- Geo-environmental engineering
